Free Shuttle Bus - Terms of Use

Reference in these terms of use to the Organiser is to UBM Asia Limited, its affiliates and authorised representatives.

1. The Shuttle Bus is for the use of registered exhibitors and visitors to the Fairs only. The Organiser may refuse admittance to the Shuttle Bus to any person, or require any person to exit the Shuttle Bus, for any reason whatsoever.
2. All passengers shall be required, prior to boarding, to produce their Hong Kong Identity Card/passport/other personal identification to the Shuttle Bus driver or other authorised representative of the Organisers (details of which may be recorded and retained for security purposes) prior to boarding the Shuttle Bus. The Organisers may prevent access to the Shuttle Bus to anyone who fails to produce satisfactory identification. The Organisers may accept admission badges for the Fairs (where identity documentation has been produced as a pre-requisite for issue) in lieu of personal identification but are under no obligation so to do. The Organiser may establish registration counters at the Fairs and issue passes for the Shuttle Bus which may be used in lieu of personal identification, but are under no obligation so to do.
3. All passengers shall comply with instructions of the Shuttle Bus driver and other authorised personnel of the Organiser whilst using the Shuttle Bus.
4. Use of the Shuttle Bus is at each passenger's own risk. The Organiser shall not be liable to any passenger for any loss of or damage to any of his or her property occurring (from whatever cause) as a result of the passenger's use of the Shuttle Bus (including whilst boarding and exiting), nor for the death or any injury sustained by any passenger in relation thereto (other than for death or injury resulting from the Organiser's negligence to the extent this cannot be excluded or restricted at law (and then only to such extent)).
5. Each passenger agrees that they shall be solely responsible for all personal possessions, samples, purchases and items taken by them on the Shuttle Bus.
6. Passengers agree that personal data provided by them to the Organisers may be used by the Organisers or passed on to third parties for all matters related to the Fairs, including security of passengers and their possessions. Whilst the Organiser may, at its discretion, post security personnel on the Shuttle Bus, it is under no obligation to do so.
7. These Terms of Use shall be governed by and construed in all respect in accordance with the laws of Hong Kong and all passengers submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Hong Kong.
8. For Security, we may station plain cloth security guard on the Shuttle Bus.
