FREDERICK MA TO SPEAK AT PRIME SOURCE FORUM

The Hon Frederick Ma, JP, Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, will welcome on behalf of the HKSAR government, delegates from all over the world who will be in Hong Kong next month for PRIME SOURCE FORUM, the annual meeting of the global Apparel Industry to be held again in the Hong Kong Convention & Exhibition Centre on 1st and 2nd April. Mr Ma will speak at a luncheon which will be held in the Ballroom of the Grand Hyatt Hotel on the first day of the Forum.
